



Cairn Hill in Ooty is a great spot for a refreshing nature walk. The trail features tall and magnificent moss-covered trees, chirping birds, and obvious signs of rich wildlife. It hosts one of the oldest Cyprus tree plantations, raised in the 1860s. Importantly the microclimate here manifests a dip in temperature with respect to the ambient temperature outside. Don't miss the interpretation center, hanging rope

Discover the scenic hills of Kotagiri and the diverse Shola forest ecosystem beaming with endemic species. This urban Shola forest resonates the success story of conservation with public participation. The Shola Reserve is recognized as an Important Bird Area (IBA) and a Ramsar wetland. Explore this trail that features marshes and streams filled with unique wildlife.

A trek to Porivarai Cave offers insight into prehistoric life. The location is at 40 kilometers from Kotagiri and accessible via a 3-kilometer hike. It features around 500 rock paintings from the Mesolithic age; the largest prehistoric rock art site in South India, showcasing animals, archers, battles, and spirals. The area is also known for its traditional honey-gathering methods from steep rocks.

The destination rewards you with a scenic viewpoint that offers panoramic views of the surrounding landscape including forested hills and valleys. The trail is sure to offer a unique experience for nature enthusiasts, hikers and adventurers.





This vibrant habitat is a botanist's delight and home to the iconic wildlife such as Lion-tailed macaque, Great Hornbill, and Nilgiri tahr. With nearby attractions like Top Slip and Parambikulam,

Manambolly is a serene getaway and a birder's paradise.

Embark on a trekking adventure at Topslip in the Anamalai Mountain Range. The climb traverses Karian shola, evergreen woodlands, sweeping grasslands and rocky boulders and summits at Pandaravarai Peak offering stunning 360-degree views. Scan the distant hill sides for the Nilgiri tahr, Indian gaurs and other wild animals. Enjoy the refreshing descent!



Admire the rich biodiversity, the rocky peaks, Mettur dam-view and the valley beneath while breathing in the misty mountain air. You'll be delighted to know that this peak is the origin point of Sarabanga river, tributary of Cauvery.

The Kullar Caves in Jawadhu Hills, Tiruvannamalai district, offer a demanding 9-kilometer trek. The route includes stream crossings and an uphill climb through diverse habitats leading to a site with ancient dolmens on a stunning mountain viewpoint. The tribal village closeby helps one to appreciate the tribal lifestyle & culture. It is an ideal trail for bird watchers, history buffs and trekking enthusiasts.

Shenbagadevi Waterfalls is a stunning 42-feet cascade located within the evergreen forests, just 6.6 km from Tenkasi. The easy trek through the beautiful forest also capture attention by virtue of a few intriguing historic rock inscriptions. The Rock bordered pool at the end point with the fragrant Shenbaga trees and the Courtallam valley-view offers much delight to hikers and families. The destination is also of religious significance attributed to Goddess Shenbaga Devi.

Located in the Western Ghats slopes of the Tenkasi district, Theerthaparai is a lesser known scenic cascade plunging from a height of over 350 feet. You'll also see the Southern Birdwing, the largest butterfly in the country in addition to several smaller species. The trek serves as a secluded getaway for those who wish to feel energised and overcome the stress of mundane life.


